The annual Ewe Hogget competition identifies the top operators and rewards excellence. Now in its 19th year the competition's objectives is to select flock replacements that are likely to be more productive and profitable over their lifetime.

WHY ENTER?

1. Your aim is to become the owner of the NZ Supreme Champion Hogget Flock
2. Have desire to benchmark hoggets with neighbours, district and nationwide
3. Prizes worth in excess of \$20,000
4. Winners of sections be invited to attend the Presentation Dinner
5. Overall winner to host a Field Day on their property
6. Special awards: Allflex, Merial Ancare Flock Performance and Ravensdown Large Flock
7. Breed sections within the competition include Perendale, Coopworth, Romney, Crossbred, Composite (three crosses or more), and Fine Wool (incorporating Merino, Corriedale, and Halfbred)

Conditions of entry

- Entrants must display 80% of replacement ewe hoggets with a minimum of 200
- Ewe hoggets must be bred by exhibitor
- Lambing date to be stated
- Ewe hoggets must be showing only milk teeth
- Ewe hoggets can be woolly or shorn
- All breeders of flock hoggets from commercial sheep are eligible
- National Winner to host a Field Day on their property
- Points awarded: Production – 50, Breed Type – 15, Breeding Objectives – 20, Wool – 15
- Hogget mating not necessary
