GENETIC POOL RETENTION

In order to prevent the decline of our genetic pool all breeders are urged to notify the N.Z.S.B.A. of any intended dispersals of registered Lincoln sheep so that their registered status might be maintained.

BREED DESCRIPTION

The Lincoln breed description and standard of excellence was written at the time of the formation of the Society and must still be the basis of breed assessment. It is the same as the one used in Australia.

However, to meet the changing needs of the industry, breeders and judges must look for more length in body, neck and leg with a finer shoulder tending to a wither, while bearing in mind that the most important breed characteristics are the pure, strong, heavy lustrous wool and longevity and constitution. The amount of head and leg cover can be a matter of personal preference providing the cover is good wool of clearly defined lock.

At all times basic structural soundness must be maintained. Performance records of both wool and meat production should be used in striving for maximum weight and quality.

LINCOLN

HEAD

Ram handsome and masculine in appearance, not too wide and coarse between the ears, with typical wool to the ears and with a well-defined forelock.

FACE

Clean and white, except for black nose.

EYES

Large, bright and expressive.

EARS

Medium size, white, blue-black spots not objectionable (pink ears and nose very objectionable).

NECK

Medium length and good thickness, well set into shoulders.

SHOULDERS

Wide sprung and well set back.

CHEST

Wide and deep.

BACK

Straight and broad, covered with thick, firmhandling flesh.

RIBS

Well sprung and deep.

HIND QUARTERS

Broad, square and deep. Leg of mutton must be full and plump.

LEGS AND FEET

Legs of medium length and strength, giving a steady appearance, well set apart. Feet set straight under legs and not too long in fetlock. Hoofs black in colour.

SKIN

Soft and pink

CARRIAGE

Standing wide and square on his legs, displaying plenty of bone, his carriage should be free and bold.

FLEECE

Very weighty and of good strength, showing character, wavy, bright, and of intense lustre. Evenness over all the body, belly and points. Long in the staple, with a broad, firm handling lock, running out so to the tip without being wasty or pointed.

Soft or what is termed 'spongy' wool objectionable.

Micron count - 36 and coarser.

NOTE - Two-months wool growth is required for inspections
