

### **DELIVERY OF TRANSFERS**

**ALL TRANSFER CERTIFICATES MUST BE DELIVERED TO THE OFFICE WITHIN TWO MONTHS OF THE TRANSACTION. VENDORS FAILING TO COMPLY WITH THIS REQUIREMENT MAY BE FINED \$60.00.**

### **INSPECTION OF EWES SOLD**

**The Council draws the attention of all breeders to the provision in Regulation 4 which requires that all ewes sold THAT REQUIRE INSPECTION must be inspected on the breeder's property BEFORE DELIVERY by an inspector nominated by the Council through the Secretary. This rule will be strictly enforced and failure of vendors to comply with this Regulation will incur such penalty as the Council shall decide.**

### **BRUCELLOSIS ACCREDITATION**

**Where veterinary certification has been received from the breeder that a flock has been accredited brucellosis free, this is indicated alongside the heading of that flock with the letters "A.B.F.". It should be noted that this advice relates to the time when the Annual Return was received and circumstances could alter.**

## **NEW ZEALAND SHEEPBREEDERS' ASSOCIATION**

1. To foster the improvement of all sheep breeds and provide a unified body whose collective voice has a beneficial effect on the total N.Z sheep industry.
2. To maintain the purity of all sheep breeds within the jurisdiction of the Association and to appoint breed inspectors and show judges to safeguard breed standards and encourage breed field days and trials.
3. To collect, verify and store pedigree information for the registration of purebred sheep and to publish the N.Z. Flock Book annually.
4. To encourage studbreeders to performance record, thereby allowing a comparison of individual animals to be made within a stud flock and identify the top performance sires within a breed and encourage their use.
5. To educate members and the general public regarding the use of registered stud rams in the production of meat and/or wool and their overall affect on the New Zealand economy.
