NOTES FOR BREEDERS

The rules and regulations of the Association are printed in full in the Flock Book which is posted to Members at the end of each year. The principal requirements for founding a flock are:-

- (1) All sheep used to found a flock must be from a flock already registered, or imported sheep from a recognised source. In every case the sheep must be eligible for registration by the Association or by another recognised body. Transfer certificates must be produced before the sheep may be registered in a new owner's name.
- (2) Every sheep in a registered flock must be individually identified by eartag. The eartag must show the flock prefix, the sheep's individual number, and its year of birth. Eartagging must be done before any sheep is two months old.
- (3) Owners must keep records which show the individual identity of every sheep in the flock, and its sire, dam, and sire of dam.
- (4) All rams used in the flock must be registered rams.
- (5) Transfers of sheep must be delivered to the purchaser by the vendor within two months of sale and vendors must forward transfers to the Association within six months of the sheep being purchased. After six months double fees must be paid, and after a year the transfer cannot be recognised.
- (6) Annual breeding returns are required by the Association. Forms are posted out to Members each year, and must be returned to the office by May 31st in each year.
- (7) No registration shall take effect unless it is in writing and delivered to the Registered Office of the Association - together with any subscription or other payments due at date of receipt of notice of resignation.
- (8) Brucellosis Accreditation - please note that sheep can only be transferred to registered flocks that are Accredited Brucellosis free. New breeders should become accredited as soon as possible after registration.

If you are in any doubt about procedure, please ask the office for guidance.

NOTES

Please write in block letters the name you wish recorded as the registered owner of the flock. For example "HIPINUI TRUST", "J.BROWN & SON LTD", "JOHN BROWN", etc.

The prefix you select may already be in use. If so, the office will let you know, and you will be asked to select another.

You should set out in the space provided the number of ewes you have bought grouping them by age, e.g. "5 born 1990", "4 born 1991", "7 born 1992", etc., with the name of the breeder and the breeder's flock number.
